



Reception arrangements Covid-19

The decree dated 19/07/21, which sets out the terms and conditions of the Sanitary Pass control, has been published (20/07/21) for application from 21/07/21.

The following areas of the campsite are therefore subject to the possession of a Sanitary Pass:

- The water park
- Indoor or outdoor entertainment venues with more than 50 people
- The bar-restaurant (from 01/08/21)

In order to make your stay as pleasant as possible and in accordance with government decisions :

The Sanitary Pass of all the adults participating in the stay will be asked only once, the day of your arrival (including for those who will present a PCR or antigenic test) and this from Wednesday 21/07/21.

This unique control will allow you to access all the services of the campsite during your entire stay.

As a reminder, the Health Pass can take the following forms:

- **Vaccination :**
 - 7 days after the 2nd injection for double injection vaccines (Pfizer, Moderna, AstraZeneca) ;
 - 4 weeks after the injection for single injection vaccines (Johnson & Johnson);
 - 7 days after injection for vaccines in people with a history of Covid (single injection).
- **A PCR or Antigenic test less than 48 hours old**
- **A positive RT-PCR or antigenic test result showing recovery of Covid-19, at least 11 days old and less than 6 months old**

All adults with an upcoming holiday, and who do not have a complete vaccination schedule or a certificate of recovery of the Covid-19 less than 6 months old, are obliged to carry out a PCR or Antigenic test 48 hours before the start of their holiday, in order to start your next holiday with a clear mind.



Cancellation condition in Covid-19 period

Due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, we are relaxing our cancellation policy as follows:

- Refund of the stay if the campsite is forced by an administrative closure not to welcome the public
- Issuance of a credit note for the amount of the stay or postponement of the dates of the stay if the client is unable to access the campsite due to border closures, administrative restrictions on travel or if one of the participants in the stay is affected by Covid-19, and the campsite is authorised to receive its clients.
